TNREADY INFORMATIONAL RUBRIC IN 6TH GRADE LANGUAGE

To get a 4 in each category you must do the following:

Focus and Organization:

- 1. Student needs to have a distinct beginning (with a hook and a thesis), middle (where everything ties back to the thesis), and end (where the thesis is restated in a different way) that is organized (perhaps through the TIDE strategy)
- 2. EVERYTHING in the essay needs to refer back to the thesis
- 3. The end needs to have another hook and restate the thesis in a new way.

Development:

- 1. Student should have at least one piece of well chosen text evidence PER body paragraph that develops his or her answer to the prompt.
- 2. EACH piece of evidence and analysis should tie back to the thesis.
- 3. Writing shows that student understands the prompt.

Language:

- 1. Student utilizes sentence variety (i.e. complex, compound, semicolons, dashes etc)
- 2. Student uses a formal tone

Conventions:

1. Punctuation is at a sixth grade level
